AN INTRODUCTION TO EATING DISORDERS FOR THE NON-SPECIALIST including overview and evidence for the role of complementary medicine practices in multi-disciplinary care

A one day workshop presented by leading Australian researchers, Professor Phillipa Hay, School of Medicine, University of Western Sydney, Professor Caroline Smith and Dr Sarah Fogarty from the National Institute of Complementary Medicine, University of Western Sydney.

This workshop will discuss the basic principles of eating disorders and evidence for the use of Complementary Medicine (CM) therapies for eating disorders in the treatment of ancillary symptoms.

- » Identifying and referral of clients with eating disorders in your practice including Eating Disorder First Aid
- A summary of the evidence base for CMs in the treatment of eating disorders
- » Practical issues in multi-disciplinary care of Eating Disorder patients.

The workshop will involve theory and practical material including case studies, and panel discussion of participants' issues and questions.

Completion of the workshop will develop practitioner awareness and understanding of eating disorders and develop confidence to work with clients who present with eating disorder symptoms in practice.

About the presenters Professor Phillipa Hay is internationally recognised for her work in eating disorders. She has a background as a psychiatrist, she is a Professor and the Chair of Mental Health

at the School of Medicine, University of Western Sydney. Professor Caroline Smith is known for her work examining the evidence base for complementary medicines, she has published on mental health disorders including eating disorders and complementary medicine.

Dr Sarah Fogarty is a researcher, practitioner and clinical trial coordinator. Sarah's PhD was on the use of Chinese Medicine for the treatment and understanding of eating disorders. Sarah has an interest in the treatment of eating disorders and translation of research into clinical practice and has published articles in this area.
